University & Program Admission Requirements:

Deadline to apply for priority consideration for fall 2018 is <u>January 5, 2018</u>.

- Applicants are admitted for fall semester only and must apply to both ISU and the EAF department
 - o ISU
 - Online application
 - Transcripts from all colleges attended
 - o EAF
 - Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA (or 3.0 for last 60 hours of coursework)
 - Essay
 - 2 letters of recommendation
 - Current resume

Selected Applicants who meet requirements will be contacted about program interviews (In person, via Skype, or phone)

Program:

- Theory to practice model
- o Cohort model capped at 25 students per year
- o 2 assistantship & 2 practicum opportunities
- 42 credit hours which requires 5 semesters full time enrollment (fall, spring, summer, fall, spring)
 - Options for comprehensive exam or thesis upon request (generally for part-time students)

Graduate Assistantships:

- A number of graduate assistantships for both master's and doctoral students are available each year
 - Our program offers a unique opportunity for students to hold an assistantship at Illinois State University, Illinois Wesleyan University, Lincoln College-Lincoln, and Heartland Community College
- O Stipends range from \$800 to \$1,000 per month for the fall and spring semesters
- Assistantships include a tuition waiver
- During the summer, students who have had graduate assistantships during the school year
 are eligible for free tuition waivers even though they do not work or earn money as a
 graduate assistant during the summer
- o Cannot hold assistantship without a 3.0 undergraduate GPA

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
