- A. Calendar Committee Update

 - 2. We will get only one year's calendar
 - 3. KM suggestion to provide parents with the start and end dates, with larger breaks ahead of time if you can't get the whole calendar to parents
 - 4. MB suggested looking at the ISU calendar to gauge when the start, end, and non-attendance days are so the school can focus on more important topics
 - 5. Dr. Jones is trying to get the calendar to allow a Fall Break around Thanksgiving time
 - 6. MJ question around why Metcalf is now looking at double the SIP days
