- E. Lab School Staff would miss the COE breakfast to show appreciation to those who work in the COE since it is the same day as the first day of schools. The COE would still like to do this for the Lab School to help keep building that tie and relationship between COE and Lab Schools so it will be hosted on Aug 13. ## VII. Reports from the Director

#### A. Admissions

- 1. Number of Applications (Metcalf 531; U High 285)
- 2. Past U-High admission numbers 2022→262, 2023→316
- 3. The HS said they no longer looked at discipline data from other schools that was submitted with apps. There was a misunderstanding about this. However, this year the principals did look at discipline data again. If needed a safety contract could be planned.
- 4. Numbers of Admits/Accepted (Metcalf-18; U High-155)
- 5. LSAC asked for more data on the breakdown, pull out the Pre-K #'s, need to track the kindergarten apps so we can see how many are not admitted after their Pre-K year

## B. LSAC Survey Responses/Priorities/Goals

- Looked at whole school demographics, did not ask families their child's grade level, but looking forward we may want to consider that to look at more trends and specific building/grade concerns
  - a) make it an optional question to choose grade
  - b) could possibly categorize lower ele(k-2), upper ele (2-4), jr hgh(5-8), HS(9-12)
  - c) push to not change the survey at all for October, but possibly future we can add grade level bands
- 2. Who can see raw data? only LSAC & Dr. Jones. The building principals do not see this
- 3. Q-How will Dr. Jones take action on the 3 areas of focus LSAC identified-? suggested we have generalized 3 area of opportunity and now up to Dr. Jones to facilitate the conversations about how to improve those areas, acknowledge the strengths and areas of opportunity and growth
- 4. Possible suggestion is to take out the neutral since apmx. 21% were neutral-this will push responders to make more of an agree/disagree choice

### VII. Open Discussion

A. Monthly Parent & Community Meetings -Should Dr.Jones have these again this year, should they be separate by school (Metcalf vs. HS), get parents back in the building and engage, PTO and Boosters could get involved to help drive families back into the school, discussion of various ideas (bring back "special" grade level celebrations/showcases, eat lunch with kiddos, parents in PE day, etc.) Megan B. is

compiling notes to give to Dr. Jones on ideas for elementary and what were "tradition" before COVID

- 1. Dr. Jones will seek suggestions from missing HS LSAC members to gather more ideas about engaging HS families
- 2.Admin (principal and Dr. Jones sessions) everyone liked this session greatly, suggesting to break out the ELE and HS sessions. Will keep the Zoom option.
- B. Mandarin- still have a few things to finalize and the conversations will continue this week to finalize some pieces of Mandarin job posting
- C. Metcalf bubble kids-k and 1 are the only grades with 3 sections, when those classes reach 5th grade they should be able to be split back into 2 sections -it was suggested to communicate with the families involved this information. Dr. Jones is unsure where Dr. Bergman landed with if the new hire for the 1st grade level teacher will travel with the class each year or not.
- D. Preschool discussion- make known it's not an automatic entry from Pre-K to K, what services should PTO and Metcalf still include or allow Pre-K with, what services are provided to Pre-K from within the school (they will ger art, PE, music, and admin assistance), the Pre-K parents build great bonds with each other when they are picking up kiddos each day
- E. School traffic- need to update the school traffic information for Metcalf,-the website is not up to date, concerns about the first few weeks of school, possibly use parent volunteers to fill in when student workers are not in session-sign up genius
- F. AC Updates for Metcalf- has not been ordered, looking at blueprints for how it will be laid out, 3rd party needs to do a review and discuss findings with facilities, Fitz will share options (how to get it cooler when AC is not available yet) and info with parents
